Puedes hacer fotos sin flash, pero no usar palos-selfie o trípodes.




No tocar plantas ni animales, ni golpear los vidrios.

A window to life

The **BioDomo** is a Window to Life that has as its core idea the **biodiversity of the planet**. It is a space that aims to understand the relationships that exist between living beings and the environment in which they live, as well as the mechanisms that allow life and the need to preserve it.

Education

It is a space that enables to increase the knowledge of the **functioning of the biosphere** and enhance the respect for nature.



Workshop

At the end of the visit there are several activities and experiences available on the **terrace of the BioDomo** that will enable the visitor to learn more about different aspects of biodiversity. In addition, on **Friday afternoon, Saturdays and Sundays**, there is an option to take part in **workshops guided by experts in areas such as botany or entomology**.

Biodomo visit rules

As in nature, it is not always easy to see the animals. You must have patience and remember that their well-being is a priority. Together we must ensure a peaceful environment. For this reason, the visitors have to keep to the following rules:



Leave in the lockers everything that is not necessary.



Do not enter with food or drink (except water).



You can take pictures without flash, but the use of selfie sticks or tripods is not allowed.



Do not touch plants or animals, or hit the glass.



Follow the instructions of the museum staff.



The maximum duration of the visit is 60 minutes.
